



Devolutions Web Login for Edge

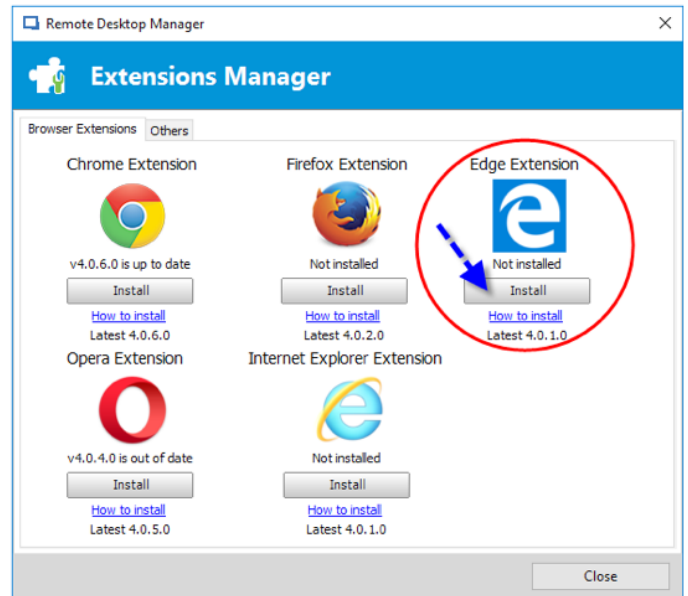

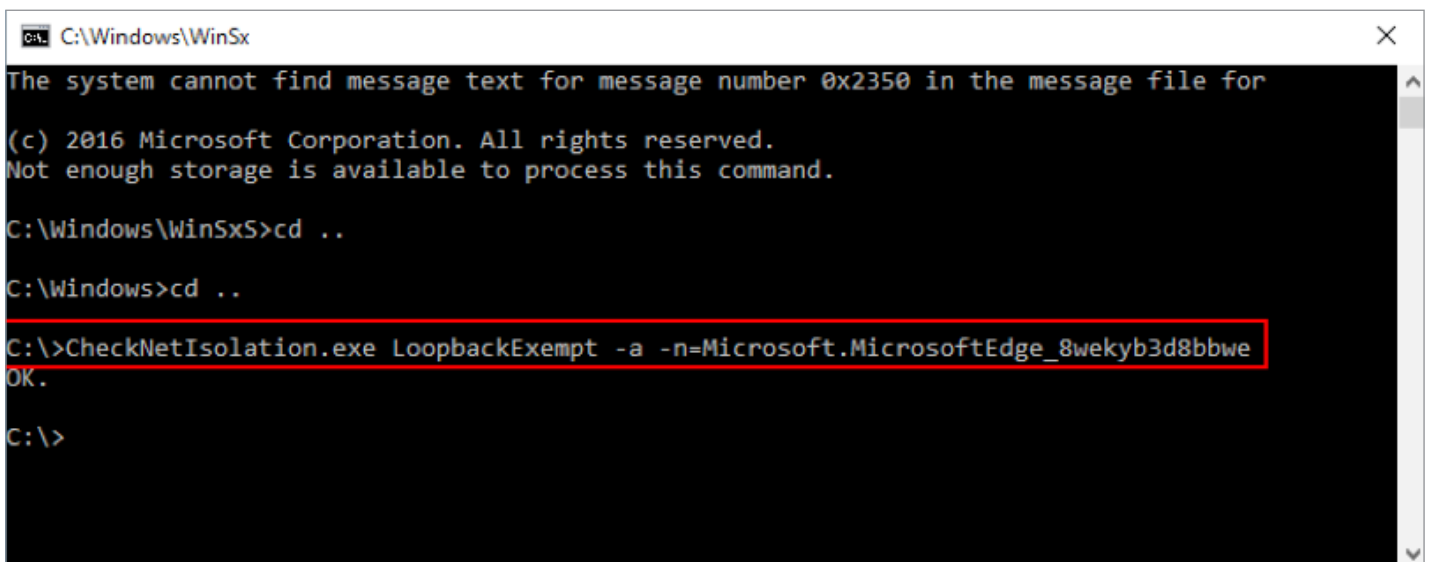
Recently, we took a look at the new [Devolutions Web Login](#), which is a handy browser extension for Remote Desktop Manager and Password Vault Manager.

Installing Devolutions Web Login on Firefox, Chrome, Opera and IE is simple and takes a few seconds. However, if you're using Microsoft Edge, there are a few more steps since Microsoft doesn't support the extension (but don't worry, it's still pretty simple!). Here's what to do:

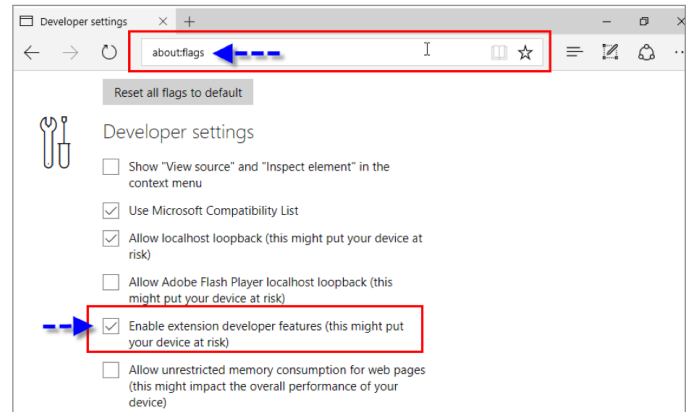
1. Download the Edge extension using the **Extension Manager**. You'll notice that compared to other browsers, Edge downloads a zip file. Unzip the file in a folder (and remember where it is because you'll need it in a few seconds).



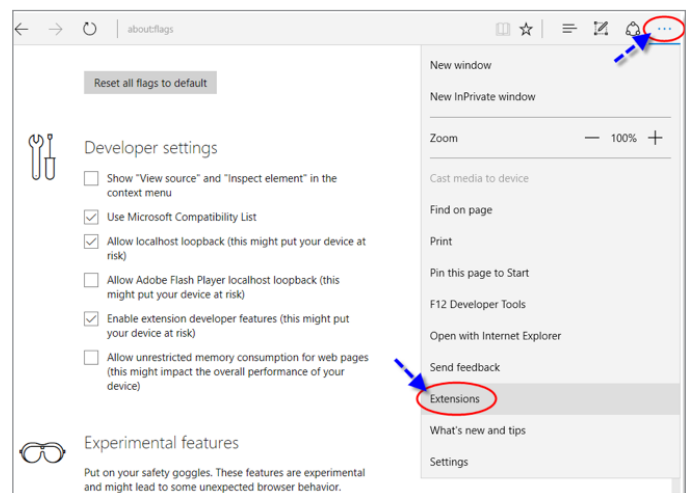
2. Open a CMD or a PowerShell window, and enter the following command to disable the loopback: **CheckNetIsolation.exe LoopbackExempt -a -n=Microsoft.MicrosoftEdge_8wekyb3d8bbwe**



3. Launch Edge and type **about:flags** in the address bar to access the Developer Settings. Check the option **Enable extension developer features**.



4. Click on the **ellipsis (...)** and select **Extension**. Click **Load extension** and select the folder where you unzipped the extension (from step 1).
