


# [New Feature Spotlight] Live Thumbnails in Remote Desktop Manager for Linux



## Thumbnail Night Live


The live thumbnails in RDM 2021.1 for Linux are not static snapshots. They are dynamic, interactive clickable sessions. For example, if you need to launch commands or update multiple servers simultaneously, you can do so directly from the Live Thumbnails tab without ever changing windows. (Please note that at the current time, this feature is available when launching an Apple Remote Desktop, VNC, or Microsoft RDP sessions.)

### **Creating Live Thumbnails**

Start by clicking Thumbnails from the View menu.



Then, to create an interactive clickable session, just press the play button located on the bottom right.



And that's all there is to it! You'll be able to keep an eye on what's happening with your sessions, which helps you save time and effort.
